It is printed now without change. Planned as a dissertation on Thomas Campion s Observations in the Art of English Poesie, it developed from Chapter V on into something like a complete treatise on English Metrics and Rime, deriving from Campion s work, and following my division of English verse into the two species of Song-verse and Speech-verse. In addition to the ordinary subjects of works on English metres, my survey, in this portion of the book, has included the relations of music and metre, of quantitative verse and accentual verse, of song, speech and chant, the function of pause in a staccato language like English, the differences between quantity and accent in English and in the Classics, the origin of rime, its function and its use. The present work deals only with Song-verse. I hope to publish in the course of the...
