Dick "creates a world irradiated by schizophrenic perceptions, and moves with frightening intensityand hilarityto an elegant transcendent finale" (Encyclopedia of Science Fiction). A visionary, Hugo Awardwinning author, Dick was inducted posthumously into the Science Fiction Hall of Fame.
